NASA faces major financial management challenges that, if not addressed, will weaken its ability to manage its highly complex programs. NASA has been on GAOs high-risk list since 1990 because of its failure to effectively oversee its contracts, due in part to the agencys lack of accurate and reliable information on contract spending. GAOs statement focuses on (1) NASAs key financial management challenges, (2) how NASAs financial management challenges compare with other federal agencies, (3) GAOs assessment of NASAs progress toward implementing recommendations aimed at improving its financial management system, and (4) the steps NASA must take to reform its financial management organization. In its related report, released today, GAO recommends that NASA develop an integrated enterprise master schedule and milestones--including improvement activities and plans, dates for completion, performance measures, and clear accountability.
