While a number of other writers contributed to the regular column, Fred himself wrote 41 instalments. This book is a compilation of those 41 classic articles, which have been extensively reworked and revised with completely new artwork especially prepared for this volume. Featuring 41 of America's greatest illustrators, this book is a showcase for hundreds of reproductions of original paintings, photographs, and tear sheets of vintage printed ephemeral materials. Each artist's life and career is discussed, and their working methods are described in detail.
