




Report of Commander W. F. Lynch, in Relation to His Mission to the Coast of Africa (Classic Reprint)

At one year old its diameter is one, and its height five inches; at thirty years its idiameter is two feet, and its height about twenty; at one thousand years its diameter is twelve or fourteen, and its height about sixty feet; and at five thousand years its lateral has so far outstripped its perpendicular growth...
