The essays in An Irrational Imp distill the insight, empathy, and wisdom of the author's long and productive life. The memories they convey range from her early twentieth-century youth in an immigrant working-class family in Boston to observations on graffiti in a women's restroom at Harvard near the century's close. They paint unforgettable images of an immigrant neighborhood, recall the tensions that etched emotional scars in a close but conflict-filled family, capture vignettes of the homefront during World War II, peer into an exceptional community of adult learners, use stories full of both grace and pathos to confront the end-of-life, and recount an extraordinary friendship developed between her and a leading New England poet in his old age. Her son, Michael B. Katz, contextualizes these memories, published from her late seventies through her early nineties, with biographical introductions to the book and each of its sections. Her long-time friend and Director of the Harvard Institute for Learning in Retirement, Leonie Gordon, provides an epilogue. Beatrice Katz understood that narrative, as much as explicitly...
