



## Others Unknown Timothy McVeigh and the Oklahoma City Bombing Conspiracy

Dimensions: 9.0in. x 6.0in. x 0.4in.In Others Unknown, Stephen Jones, Timothy McVeighs lawyer in his trial for the 1995 bombing of the Murrah Office Building in Oklahoma City, provides the fullest possible account of the worst act of terrorism in American history. In a complete revision of his 1998 hardcover, Jones tells for the first time the whole story of his investigation of the case, including what he was told by McVeigh and what he learned about others involved in the conspiracy. His account differs significantly from the tale McVeigh is telling as he faces execution for his crimes. In interviews with Buffalo News journalists, reported in their recently released book American Terrorist(ReganBooks, April 2000), McVeigh claims total responsibility for the bombing, saying It was my choice and my control to hit that building when it was full. In Others Unknown Jones sets the record straight, saying what he could not say when he first wrote this book, before McVeigh effectively waived attorney-client privilege: that based on what he learned as McVeighs counsel, Jones knows that the bombing was a conspiracy, and that McVeigh was not its mastermind.
