The underlying idea was that to advance in each of the above research topics, integration with and attention to others is necessary. The overall rationale of the BVAI symposium wasbasedonamultidisciplinary approachofbiophysicsandneurobiology, visual and cognitive sciences and cybernetics, dealing with the interactions of natural and articial systems. BVAI was conceived and organized by a group of researchers active in the BVAI topics of the Institute of Cybernetics E. Caianiello of the Italian National Research Council, Pozzuoli, Naples (ICIB-CNR), with the support of the Italian Institute for Philosophical Studies (IISF), and the help of the Macscopic Quantum Coherence and Computing Association (MQC2). BVAI was sponsored by the EBSA (European Biophysics Societies Association) which in particular provided travel grants for deserving young participants from outside Italy. The symposium was held under the auspices of the AIIA (Italian Asso- ation of Articial Intelligence), GIRPR (Italian Group of Researchersin Pattern Recognition),...
