GAO reported on the scope of the overall programs, the working relationship of the federal employees to Saudi personnel, and the perceptions of U.S. employees. Federal employees who are involved in an economic cooperation program with Saudi Arabia work under the auspices of either the U.S.-Saudi Arabian Joint Commission on Economic Cooperation, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, or the U.S. Geological Survey Mission. These employees have their salaries and benefits reimbursed to them by the Saudi Government at an annual cost to the Saudis of over \$80 million. Recruitment of U.S. employees for Saudi Arabia generally follows the normal procedures and practices used to recruit federal employees, and the required approval by the Saudis is usually forthcoming. The restrictive living conditions, high costs, and generally unfavorable climatic conditions that exist in Saudi Arabia make it necessary for private concerns and the U.S. Government to provide additional allowances and benefits to...
