Department of Agriculture gives notice that: Shipments containing more than five percent of bad eggs will be regarded as violating the Food and Drugs Act. In the opinion of that Department, eggs which contain yolks stuck to the shell (Spots), Blood Rings, Red or White Rots, Green

Whites, Sour Rots, Moldy Eggs, and any other eggs which consist wholly or in part of a filthy, decomposed, or putrid substance, are adulterated. Eggs which are adulterated may be shipped in interstate or foreign commerce for use in tanning or other technical ways, without violating the provisions of the Food and Drugs Act only, if they are first denatured so as to render them incapable of being used for food. Since it is impracticable to denature eggs in the shell, adulterated eggs must be broken out and denatured prior to shipment. Both the Federal and State authorities are determined to enforce the laws governing the sale of bad...
