

All the important points in this comparison are against New England as a field of operations under our system of management. We who are yet living, are unconsciously prone to imagine that those who have passed on, have-because of their passing-contributed much less of duration than we who are left; but in the great scheme of life, of which this 10-year-period is but characteristic of what is taking place continuously, and in any. other 10-year-period, we see that the duration of the living is on the same plane with that of the deceased: Viz: In New England, 20,572 deceased members gave an average contributive life of 10.65 years each In New England, 1,481,038 aggregated living members gave an average contributive...
