Villette was Charlotte Bronts fourth novel; it was preceded by and is a reworking of the posthumously published The Professor, her first novel, and then by Jane Eyre and Shirley. Villette begins with its famously passive protagonist, Lucy Snowe, age 14, staying at the home of her godmother Mrs. Bretton in the clean and ancient town of Bretton, in England. Also in residence are Mrs. Brettons son, John Graham Bretton (whom the family calls Graham), and a young visitor, Paulina Home (who is called Polly). Polly is a peculiar little girl who soon develops a deep devotion to Graham, who showers her with attention. But Pollys visit is cut short when her father arrives to take her away. For reasons that are not stated, Lucy leaves Mrs. Brettons home a few weeks after the...
