I have no doubt but the hills have been elevated farther subsequent to thelted Reds, but the shattered condition of the Carboniferous limestone and the underlying sandstone (July 2-1) is so complete, that it shows plainly that the Red Beds, if overlying, could, not have escaped a similar breaking up. I have seen the former made up of limestone and sandstone in augular pieces of all sizes to 0 feet, thoroughly mixed, the whole stained red, overlain by the Red Beds, undisturbed beyond a gentle dip. All the other formations—those of the Cretaceous—are in this respect like the Red Beds. There must also have been a still earlier upheaval, throwing out the Devonian, unless that be represented in the great limestone formation. I have said the granite shows apparently an increasing redness...
