It covers a wide variety of topics, such as mutual perception and awareness, the creation of images and stereotypes, translations and fictional representations, travel accounts and newspaper reports. Some essays deal with particular areas of British awareness of Russian culture, or of individual writers (such as the fabulist Ivan Krylov), others recount individual British encounters with Russia.
