We are pleased to present the proceedings of the 13th European Conference on Machine Learning (LNAI 2430) and the 6th European Conference on Principles and Practice of Knowledge Discovery in Databases (LNAI 2431). These two conferences were colocated in Helsinki, Finland during August 19-23, 2002. ECML and PKDD were held together for the second year in a row, following the success of the colocation in Freiburg in 2001. Machine learning and knowledge discovery are two highly related fields and ECMLPKDD is a unique forum to foster their collaboration. The benefit of colocation to both the machine learning and data mining communities is most clearly displayed in the common workshop, tutorial, and invited speaker program. Altogether six workshops and six tutorials were organized on Monday and Tuesday. As invited speakers we had the pleasure to have Erkki Oja (Helsinki Univ. of Technology), Dan Roth (Univ. of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign), Bernhard Scholkopf (Max Planck Inst. for Biological Cybernetics, Tubingen), and Padhraic Smyth (Univ. of California, Irvine). The main events ran from Tuesday until Friday, comprising 41 ECML technical papers and 39 PKDD papers. In total, 218...
