These two c- ferences were colocated in Helsinki, Finland during August 1923, 2002. ECML and PKDD were held together for the second year in a row, following the success of the colocation in Freiburg in 2001. Machine learning and knowledge discovery are two highly related elds and ECMLPKDD is a unique forum to foster their collaboration. The benet of colocation to both the machine learning and data mining communities is most clearly displayed in the common workshop, tutorial, and invited speaker program. Altogether six workshops and six tutorials were or- nized on Monday and Tuesday. As invited speakers we had the pleasure to have Erkki Oja (Helsinki Univ. of Technology), Dan Roth (Univ. of Illinois, Urbana- Champaign), Bernhard Scholkopf (Max Planck Inst. for Biological Cybernetics, Tubingen), and Padhraic Smyth (Univ. of California, Irvine).
