The emphasis is not on spelling, grammar, and handwriting (though this becomes part of the fun), but on reinforcing kids ideas and how to communicate them effectively. Through writing, everyone in the family learns how to express their feelings to one another, resolve conflicts more easily, grow closer as a family, and get to know each other better. Better yet, families share time together and create lasting memories.
