




Duds: Notable Failures in the Land of Success (Paperback)

Hamburg explores in some detail over 300 examples over the past half century +, divided into 18 categories from crime and products to movies and social movements. What emerges is a tapestry of a changing American temperament and how it is constantly shaped and reshaped by public and private institutions. On one level, the book is an adventure in pure nostalgia - regardless of your age, it s a time machine back to the personalities, ideas, and merchandise you lived with, consumed, rejected, marveled...
