Simply put, these companies are applying an unacceptable double standard. The disparity is shocking. In Germany and Japan, Pizza Hut and McDonald s contribute 50 percent of the cost of employee health insurance, but according to a recent report by the Health Care Reform Project, they pay far less to cover their workers here at home. It might be understandable if foreign corporations were exploiting American workers; but...
