I say, sir, constituents, for, in my theory of this Government, we are all the representatives of the People, though chosen after a different manner. Every infraction of the Constitution, however unimportant it may appear in its immediate consequences, tends to diminish the general confidence in the stability of our Government, and the general attachment to it; and as the People of the State I have the honor in part to represent are devotedly...
