Though best known worldwide for his commentary on the books of Daniel and the Revelation, the reader of these pages will be impressed by Elder Smith s scholarly presentations on a wide range of religious topics. Many will be surprised to learn how prolific and refined were his poetic skills. Smith, Uriah (1832-1903)- Editor, administrator, preacher, prophetic expositor, professor, poet, inventor, and artist-engraver. Smith was born in New Hampshire, and accepted the message of Sabbatarian Adventism after hearing James and Ellen White in 1852. He joined the Whites in their publishing of The Advent Review and Sabbath Herald after their move to Rochester, NY, becoming editor at age 23 when the periodical moved to Battle Creek, Michigan the fall of 1855. He remained until 1897 in this position with little interruption, assisting James White until his death in 1881, and then taking over full charge. Smith authored 20 books and approximately 4000 editorials, impacting the church over that span of time...
