Both writers were well known figures in the dog world during that period, with Dalziel being the author of British Dogs, one of the great canine classics. The first part of the book by Pathfinder deals with training dogs for use in the field. One hundred and fifty five pages contain five detailed chapters on: - Companionable Retrievers. - Field Retrievers. - Pointers and Setters. - Field Spaniels. - Terriers. The second part by Dalziel offers sound advice on the training of non - sporting dogs for various tasks....
