Bishop E. E. Hoss, of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, had charge of this service. The opening hymn was: O Thou, who earnest from above, The pure celestial fire to impart. The Commissioners present, about forty in number, recited the Apostles Creed, the confession of our one faith. Hymn No. 368 was sung: O love divine, how sweet thou art! When shall I find my willing heart All taken up by thee? Bishop Hoss read the Scriptures - a selection from the fourth chapter of Ephesians, I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, etc. - making various pertinent comments.
