Positive effects, besides division of labour, of an application of the decentralization principle to a firms organization were not taken into account. In order to do so, a decision model for a hypothetical industrial organization has been developed, leading to a comparison of the effectiveness of various more or less decentralized organization structures. The problem appears to be one in capital budgeting, where management is required to generate information of sub-unit performance through a heuristic routine. System alternatives may be ranked by one or more evaluation criteria, the one with highest rank, compared to present achievement, indicating steps toward desirable organizational change of the system.
