




Miller Plays: All My Sons , Death of a Salesman , The Crucible , A Memory of Two Mondays , A View from the Bridge v. 1 (Paperback)

All five plays were written by Arthur Miller within a ten-year period which began with his first Broadway hit in 1947: With the production of All My Sons, wrote Brooks Atkinson in the New York Times, the theatre has acquired a genuine new talent. This hit was followed by an even greater play: Death of a Salesman. A great play of our day, wrote the New York Herald Tribune and the play has gone on to become the classic American tragedy of Willy Loman, a salesman who becomes disillusioned with the American dream. The Crucible (1953) was produced during the McCarthy era and became a parable of the witch-hunting practises of a government rooting out Communists. A View from the Bridge (1955) concerns the lives of longshoremen in the Brooklyn waterfront and has remained one of Miller's most produced plays. A Memory of Two Mondays, a one-act play, was...
