He is best known for his historical adventure stories that were popular in the late 19th century. His works include *The Dragon The Raven* (1886), *For The Temple* (1888), *Under Drake s Flag* (1883) and *In Freedom s Cause* (1885). George Alfred Henty, better known as G.A. Henty, began his storytelling career with his own children. After dinner, he would spend an hour or two in telling them a story that would continue the next day. Some stories took weeks! A friend was present one day and watched the spell-bound reaction of his children suggesting Henty write down his stories so others could enjoy them. He did. Henty wrote approximately 144 books in addition to stories for magazines and was known as *The Prince of Story-Tellers* and *The Boy s Own Historian*. One of Mr. Henty s secretaries reported that he would quickly pace back and forth in his study dictating stories as fast as the secretary could record them. G. A. Henty was born...
