The entries cover: - the organisation s specific charitable activities - how the charity is organised and managed, including the part played by volunteers - how the charity is funded, including the value of donations and the relevant fundraising costs - how fully the charity explains and reports on its activities. To give a broader picture of the sector, the book includes around 20 entries on major groupings of mainly smaller or local charities, such as local youth clubs and Citizens Advice Bureaux. it also provides listings showing, for example, levels of volunteer input, costs, staffing and different forms of income, to help readers place individual charities in a wider context.
