As extensive and radical changes had been made in the plan of medical teach ing in that school, it seemed proper that a full statement should be given of the reasons for such reforms. An attempt was made, therefore, to present fairly the then position of medical teaching in America, to point out its chief defects, and to indicate the causes that had led to them, and the evils to which they in turn gave rise. The second Address was delivered sixteen years later, in Oc tober, 1893, at the opening of the Four Years Course of Medical Study. It is hoped it may serve to indicate the advances effected in the interval, and also the lines along which further progress should...
