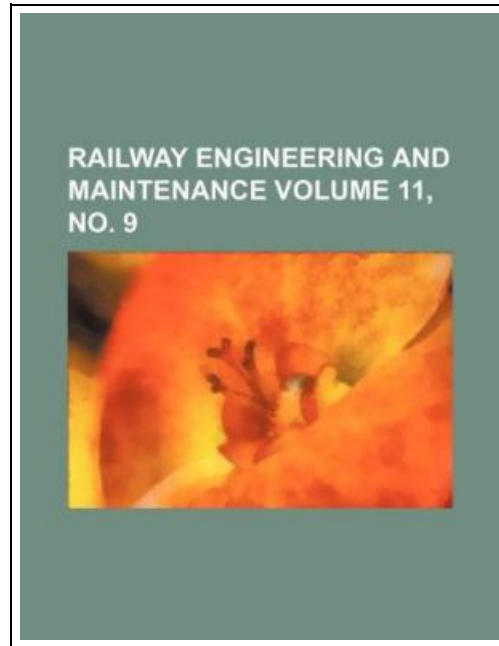

Before the year 1908 the brand and heat numbers were on the same side of the rail. Carnegie Steel Co. (Edgar Thomson Works.) Before January 1, 1913 the Bessemer heats were started with number one for each quarter and numbered consecutively until the beginning of the next quarter, so that it was possible to have four heats with the same number each year. The heat would then have to be identified by the month rolled. The heat numbers were hand stamped and consisted of from one to five figures. They appeared three times in a rail length. O. H. steel was marked with five figures, and O. H. stamped to their right, on the side of the rail opposite the brand. The same intervals were used. Beginning with January 1, 1913, the markings are as follows: Bessemer heats are stamped consecutively throughout the year instead of quarterly. The heat number consisting of five figures is found three times on a rail length. The rail letter is machine stamped to the right of it. O. H. furnaces are numbered from 1 to 14, inclusive. The heat number is of four or five figures. The first or first two to the left indicate the furnace, the last one, or two or three the heat number. O. H. is stamped immediately to the right of the heat number. Colorado Fuel and Iron Co. Formerly the heat number consisting of from one to four...
