The study was based on the companies that are listed in the Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE). The Data used was extracted from the Financial Statements of these companies and share price data from the NSE. It was then transformed into a suitable form to serve the purpose of the study. Multiple Regression and Correlation Analysis techniques were used to analyse the data and the results showed that the relevant factor for the NSE companies was Dividend Payout Ratio as opposed to Dividend Yield for mature markets. However the study made several recommendations, both for policies and further research.
