Also they occur so constantly and are so common that in all their stages, they frequently come under the notice of even the common people, but for want of a proper knowledge and observation ordinary people fail to see the connection between the caterpillar which eats the leaves, the dormant pupa and the butterfly which incessantly flutters about under trees, over bushes and plants and not infrequently in houses or even over one's head.
