SM; then ESM is a straight line. For, since ZPMC 180-PAC 180-CSL, the points C, L, S, M are in a circle. Therefore ZMSC MLC 180-EBC 180-ESC, that is, MSC ESC 180, therefore E, S, M are in one straight line. Otherwise: Since the ZPMA FCA FSA, therefore ZAMN ASN, therefore A, S, M, N are in a circle, therefore ASM ANM 180. But ANM EBA ESA, thereforeESA ASM 180, therefore, as before, E, S, M are in a straight line. Hence EM passes through S, the intersection of DL or FN with the circle, and, by (1), DL, EM, FN all intersect in the same point on the circle, therefore they all pass through the same point S found in (1). 3. Lastly, produce BC to meet PQ in L, and join LS meeting the circle ABC in D. Then, since DL. LS...
