

Tests of these meters made by careful current meter measurements of the flow in the Wachusett Aqueduct, indicate that for rates of flow between 48,000,000 and 110,000,000 gallons in 24 hours the meters will register and record the flow within 2 per cent. of accuracy. The wheels and generators are supported on a foundation of heavy concrete masonry forming wells, into some of which the draft tubes from the turbines discharge, while others contain valves controlling the flow of water.
