Joseph Rudyard Kipling (30 December 1865 - 18 January 1936) was an English short-story writer, poet, and novelist. He wrote tales and poems of British soldiers in India and stories for children. He was born in Bombay, in the Bombay Presidency of British India, and was taken by his family to England when he was five years old. Kipling s works of fiction include The Jungle Book (a collection of stories which includes Rikki-Tikki-Tavi ), the Just So Stories (1902), Kim (1901), and many short stories, including The Man Who Would Be King (1888). His poems include Mandalay (1890), Gunga Din (1890), The Gods of the Copybook Headings (1919), The White Man s Burden (1899), and If- (1910). He is regarded as a major innovator in the art of the short story; his children s books are enduring classics of children s literature; and one critic described his work as exhibiting a...
