No compilation of nature poetry would be complete without contributions from William Wordsworth, whose Lines Written in Early Spring and To a Skylark appear here. Other featured poets include John Milton, Alfred Tennyson, Robert Herrick, George Herbert, Mary Howitt, and many other writers whose meditations on flowers, birds, woodlands, and summer evenings remain ever green.
