

The book ranges nimbly from the sciences of sound and light to the astonishing intersection of the pendulums oscillations and quantum theory, resulting in new insight into the make-up of the material universe. Covering topics from the invention of time zones to Isaac Newtons equations of motion, from Pythagoras theory of musical harmony to Michael Faradays field theory and the development of quantum electrodynamics, Galileos Pendulum is an authoritative and engaging tour through time of the most basic all-pervading system in the world.
