We (myself and my two teenaged children, Frank Lance Jr. and Zoe Lance) word processed them from a fading typewritten manuscript. We were faithful to the original manuscript, simply proofreading as we went along. My father started up many small poetry magazines in Chicago, none of which are extant today. He was part of the burgeoning beatnik coffee-house culture that was springing up in big cities in the country at that time. I am happy to have rescued these stories from oblivion, not only because the author is my father, but also because they are very good stories.
