McCormack on June 24th of this year, his part as a pioneer in secondary education has been brought to a close; but what he was accomplished in the La Salle-Peru Township High School and his influence in education circles in general, as well as his many excellent articles and translations, insure him immortality, for something of the soul of a man is attached to the work which he has produced, and the good in it lives on for the future to use and to build upon as he has used the work of his predecessors to form his life and to create of molding ideas. He continued his education in Germany spending a term each at the universities of Leipzig and Tubingen, where he devoted himself to the study of History, Political Science, and the Modern Languages. After his return to the United States, he took up the study of jurisprudence first at Columbia and later at the Chicago Law School where he received...
