Relatively little has been done, however, to define clearly the functions and responsibilities of managers, the qualities and experience they should possess, the special preparation, if any, they should undergo, or their relation to other parts of a moving housing program. In its first management training course NAHO has made a start on these problems but much remains to be done. Organizations of non-officials, I am sure, would also admit that they have more questions than answers on the really important phases of housing management. As its title suggests, in this book Mr. Goldfeld has not tried to give a systematic answer to these questions. It is an abridged edition of the diary he kept during the earlier days of his work as manager of the Lavanburg Homes on the lower east side of New York with...
