It has been written and designed to be used either in conjunction with the BBC Schools TV series of the same name, or independently as a skills book. The book is almost entirely in French to facilitate target language use in the classroom. Activities are practical and include information gap, pair-work and role-play tasks, encouraging students to use real French in a "real" situation. An accompanying cassette is available separately and contains much new material, as well as some recordings from the TV programme.
