Finding 2 ATF Could Improve the Referral Process to the Field Divisions The Brady Branchs process for sending referrals to field divisions could be improved. First, the referral packages are not as complete and easy to interpret as they could be. Second, the referrals are sometimes not timely, or are even lost between the Brady Branch and the field divisions. Several factors have contributed to the need for an improved referral process, including that (1) ATF has not fully utilized the Brady Branch resources, because the NICS program and Brady Branch are relatively new, (2) the Brady Branch must mail its referral packages to the field divisions because the Branchs information system does not communicate with the fields system, and (3) there are no controls in place to ensure the referral packages sent to field divisions are actually received. As a result, ATF has not made the most efficient use of both...
