Excerpt from Common Insects and Diseases of the Apple The Winter Spray. Spray at any time when the tree is dormant, preferably just before the leaf buds open, with concentrated lime-sulphur solution diluted as recommended on page 16. Controls, or helps to control or prevent, San Jose scale, green aphis, rosy aphis, apple scab, leaf spot and bitter rot. For control of heavy infestations of San Jose scale spray twice, once in the fall and again in late winter, with soluble oil, or lime-sulphur, or both. The Summer Spray Schedule. (1) Spray after the bloom petals have fallen and before the calyx cups close with five quarts commercially-made lime-sulphur (or its equivalent of the homemade) and one pound powdered lead arsenate to fifty gallons water. For codling moth, curculio, aphis, scab, leaf spot, etc. (2) Two to three weeks later with the same formula as for (1). For codling moth, etc. (3) Three weeks after second application spray with Bordeaux mixture (see page 31), adding one pound powdered lead arsenate to each fifty gallons. For bitter rot, ...
