Book of Beliefs , arguably owes something to Henry Miller's Book of Friends in its informal structure and the subtitle of which, viz. The Omegala , is an oblique tribute to anything omega-orientated, is more informally cyclic than Eternal Life (1995), its immediate precursor in John O Loughlin's aphoristic canon, but remains, nonetheless, one of the most comprehensively exacting and demanding of all his philosophical works, and also, in the long run, one of the most thematically rewarding.
