

Glcis, Lebanon; member of the executive committee, David J. Reese, Philadelphia. Mr. Reese has been the efficient secretary of the association since 1914, but press of other business made it impossible for him to accept a renomination this year. The invitation of the Western Pennsylvania members to visit them next year was accepted, and the Hotel Schenly, Pittsburgh, was chosen as the meeting place, June 19, 20 and 21, 1917....
