The third, A Rich Man in Jail shows a man who is trapped by his wealth, and learns a lesson about greed. The fourth The Trick of Gold is about a boy who learns about the real depth of knowledge. All these stories are based upon the oral folktales of China that Dr. Yang heard while growing up, and they contain strong moral messages. Illustrated with original Chinese paintings, the stories are retold by Dr. Yang, Jwing-Ming.
