About 1,900 Phrases, Proverbs, Couplets, Odes, etc., are explained, but few of which, so far as the writer is aware, have been previously published. The hundred pages devoted to Puns and other Linguistic Diversions, embracing more than 300 examples, open into an expansive territory, hitherto singularly neglected. Those who have not examined the proverbial sayings of the Chinese are surprised at the richness of the language in this respect. The inquiry has been often made where so many proverbs are to be found, and the suggestion occasionally hazarded that the author made them up out of his own head. Those most acquainted with the resources of the colloquial will best understand how unnecessary is such a theory. Only a small part of the ample materials available has been here presented.
