Kraemers are a prominent name in that heritage with Kraemer descendants engaged today in road building, bridge construction and building construction and construction-related businesses such as heating and air conditioning, lumber, plumbing, carpentry, electrical and masonry as well as many small businesses (farming, cheese making) and the professions (medicine, law, education) throughout the State. Their heritage extends back to 1649 in Tiefenbach, Bavaria, Germany where the first known Kraemer (Johann or Hansquot;) married Barbara Leonhard at St. Vitus Catholic Church in Tiefenbach. Johann Kraemer was not in construction or the professions, but was a humble weaver who eked out a living by weaving linen. He and his wife died at age 33 leaving a son age nine and a one year old daughter. How then did we all get here? quote;Wisconsin Kraemers: I. The old world of Bavariaquote; tells the remarkable story of six generations of these Kraemers as they struggled with the devastation of hand-weaving by the industrial revolution and had to shift to peasant farming...
