The author of the Acts of the Apostles is not named but, according to Church tradition it is generally considered that he was the Luke named as the companion of the apostle Paul. This is supported by the fact that parts of the book are written in the first person plural, suggesting that the author was a travelling companion of Paul whilst he was on his missionary journeys. The author claims in his opening preamble that he was the author of the Gospel of St. Luke, so this assumption appears to be founded on relatively safe ground. The account concludes with the imprisonment of Paul in Rome, in approximately 63AD, which...
